The AmeriCorps SC Service Commission is a pass-through agency that subgrants federal funds to schools, government agencies and non-profit organizations throughout South Carolina. State funds will support public services in areas of education, environment, healthy futures, economic opportunity, military and veteran services and emergency and disaster preparedness.

AmeriCorps is also a workforce development program which trains and prepares participants to enter the workforce with transferable skills and technical training.
